

# Employment, Unemployment and Hours and Earnings 2010 Annual Averages

## West Virginia 2010 Annual Averages

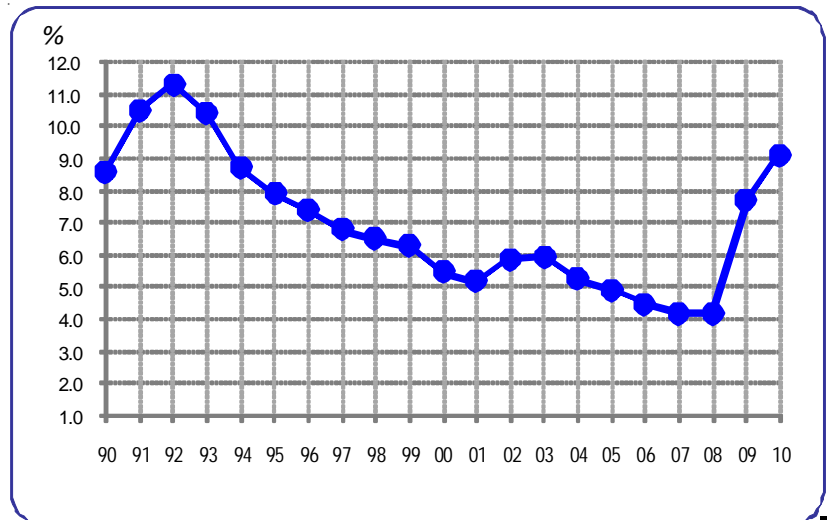
West Virginia recorded an average annual unemployment rate of 9.1 percent in 2010, the highest average annual rate for the state since 1993. The average civilian labor force declined 15,000 to 782,000, while the resident-based total employment fell 24,000 to 711,000. Average total unemployment climbed 9,000 to 71,000. Annual average total nonfarm payroll employment grew by 300 jobs during 2010. The goods-producing sector fell 2,800, with losses of 1,500 in construction and 1,400 in manufacturing. Mining and logging added 100 jobs. The service-providing sector added 3,100 jobs, with notable gains of 2,600 in government and 1,800 in educational and health services. The largest service-providing decline was 1,400 in trade, transportation, and utilities.

In 2010, government employment made up the largest percentage of total nonfarm payroll employment in West Virginia, 20.5 percent, or one in five jobs. Trade, transportation, and utilities made up 18.0 percent of the total employment, followed by educational and health services at 16.2 percent, leisure and hospitality at 9.7 percent, professional and business services at 8.1 percent, other services at 7.4 percent, manufacturing at 6.6 percent, construction at 4.4 percent, mining and logging at 4.0 percent, financial activities at 3.8 percent, and information at 1.4 percent.

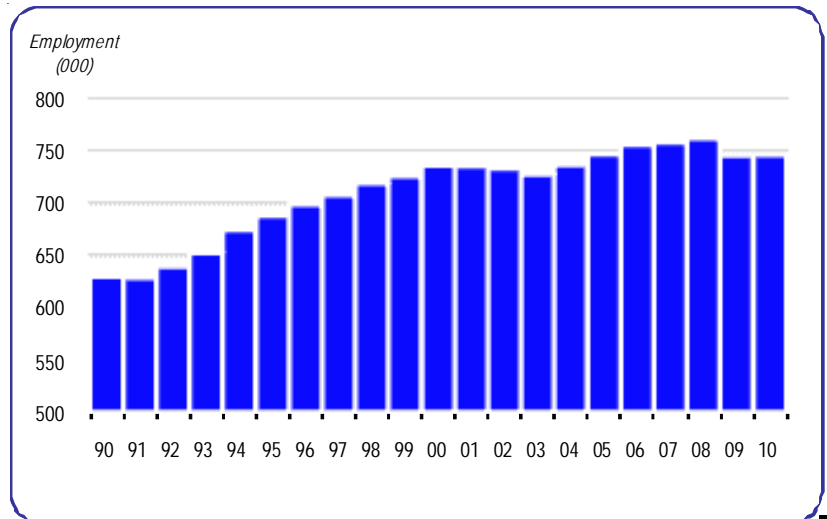

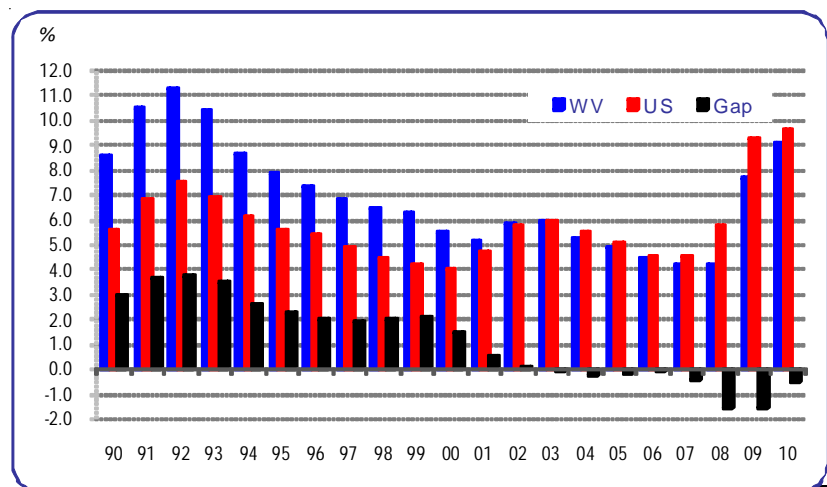
West Virginia Unemployment Rate 1990 - 2010

US - WV Unemployment Rate Comparison

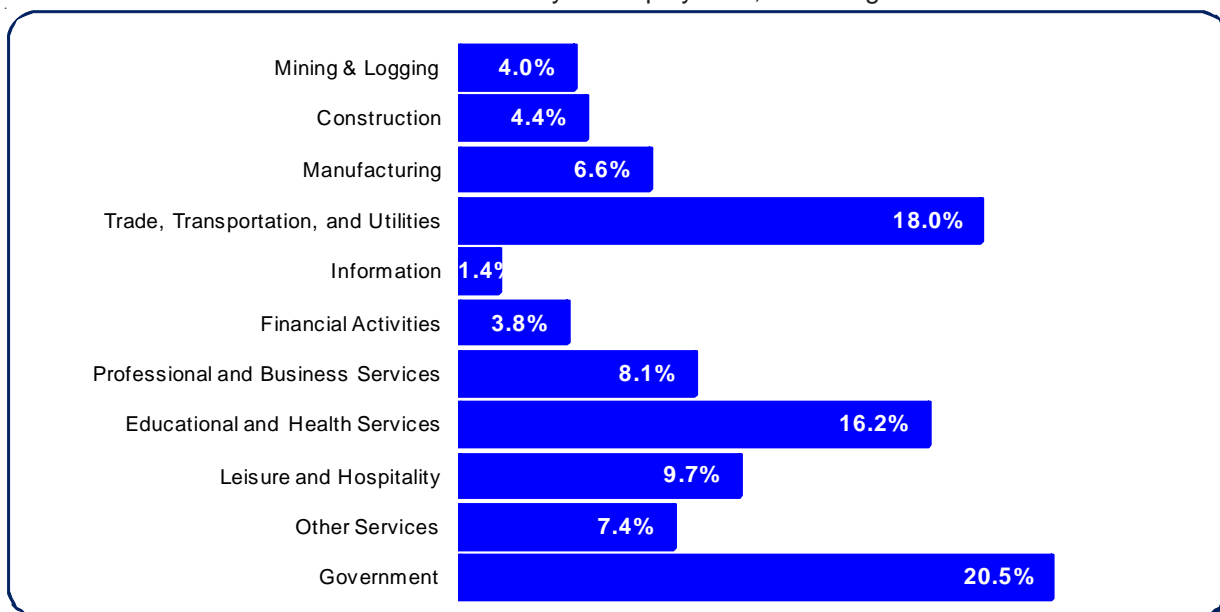

Percent of Total Nonfarm Payroll Employment, West Virginia 2010

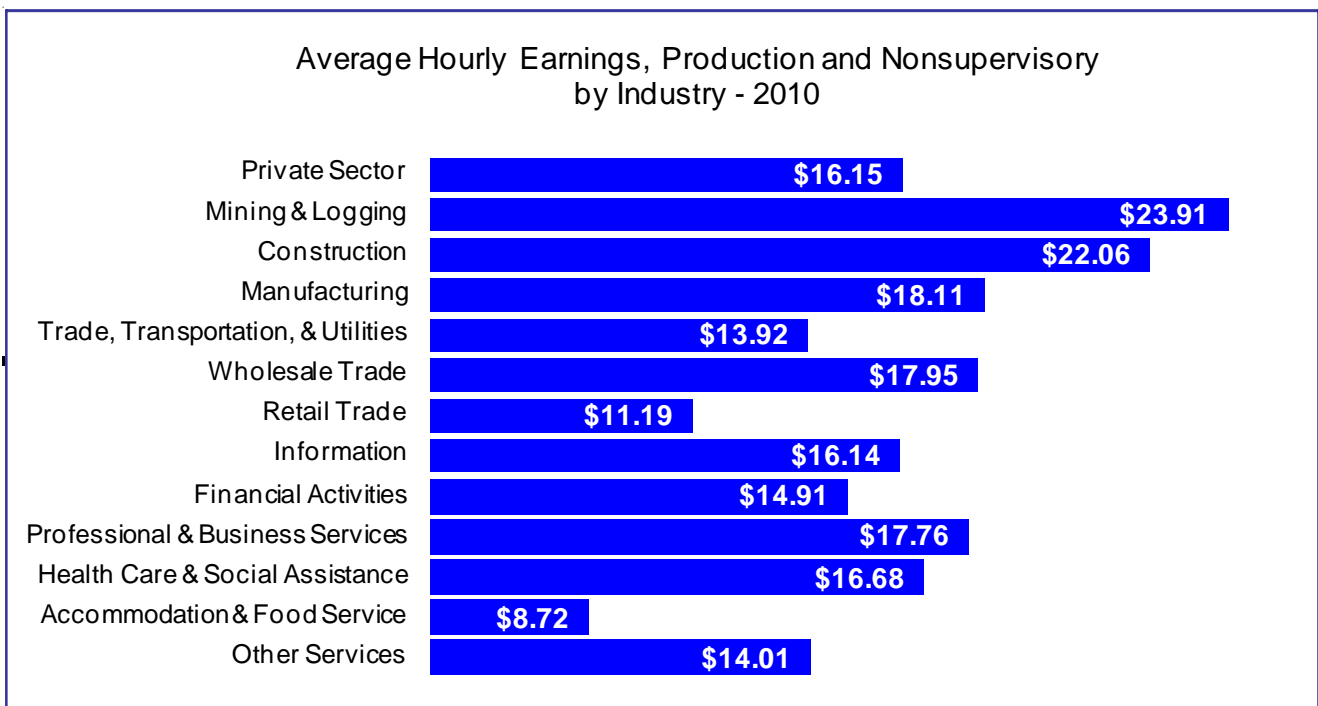
