<p>With continuing mine closures and layoffs in the mining industry. WFWV submitted an application for a new Coal Mining NDWG in January of 2018, to request additional funds and time to continue to serve the dislocated coal miner and displaced homemaker. On March 12, 2018, WFWV was awarded funding in the amount of \$1,056,000.00 to serve 200 additional participants. The Performance Period is March 12, 2018 – December 31, 2019. The supportive services amount to be paid in this grant is \$25.00 per day, changing from \$20.00 paid on the prior Coal Mining Grant. UMWACC will continue to serve as the Project Operator through a Sole Source Procurement. A grant agreement has been signed with the Project Operator, UMWACC, Inc. Participants are now being enrolled in the new grant. Currently a modification for a supplement of funds has been submitted to USDOL. No funds have been awarded in response to the application as of 6/12/2019. Laid off coal miners and displaced Homemakers are continuing to be seen and signed up for training as funds are still available. Referrals are being made to the AJC's for WIOA Funded training until an approval for additional funds are approved.</p>

<p>On February 17, 2018 Severe Storms and flooding caused damage to 22 counties in the state of WV under FEMA DR-4359 as follows, Brook, Cabell, Doddridge, Hancock, Harrison, Lincoln, Logan, Mason, Marshall, Monongalia, Ohio, Pleasants, Preston, Ritchie, Taylor, Tyler, Wayne, Wetzell, Wirt, and Wood . An application was submitted to USDOL for disaster relief clean-up and WFWV was awarded an award for \$2,500,000.00 with an initial incremental award of \$833,325.00 to serve 140 participants. HRDF, Inc was selected as Project Operator through a RFP Process and Bidders Conference. The Performance Period is 10/1/2018 to 9/30/2019. Disaster work began 1/1/2019. A modification was submitted to USDOL for an additional increment of \$1,666,675.00 to continue disaster relief employment activities. The application has been approved for another increment of \$800,000.00. The Project Operator has been awarded the funds and work activities are continuing. Another modification has been submitted for an extension of additional time to extend 12 months from 10/1/2019 to 9/30/2020.</p>

<p>Severe Storms, Flooding, Landslides and Mudslides in the Eastern Panhandle of West Virginia struck May 28, 2018 till June 3, 2018 and caused severe damages. A State of Emergency was declared and FEMA assessed the damage and declared a disaster under FEMA DR-4378 as follows, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Jefferson, Mineral, Morgan and Pendleton. A application was submitted to USDOL and \$975,000.00 was awarded for temporary disaster relief employment for 65 participants. HRDF, Inc has been selected as the Project Operator through a RFP Process Bidders Conference . The Performance Period is 10/1/2018 to 9/30/2019 . Disaster work began 1/1/2019. A modification has been submitted for a no-cost performance period extension from 10/1/2019 to 6/30/2020.</p>

On 5/24/2019 an award of \$10,000,000.00 was given to WorkForce WV with an initial increment of \$3,333,333.00. The performance period for this grant will be July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021. A bidders conference was scheduled for 7/9/2019 for the selection of a project operator. Awaiting proposals to be returned.</p>
